

***Kelmarsh Country Show  
Campsite Rules 2020***

***12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> June 2018***

***Campsite Facilities***

- Each pitch will be 9m x 9m in size and will accommodate your vehicle which is limited to 1.
- Firebreaks of 6m minimum width will be left between rows.
- Fire Points will be placed in the campsite.
- A campsite team will be appointed. This will be a member of Kelmarsh Show Team along with security. They will take responsibility for the safe management of the campsite.
- A welcome team will direct you to your pitch.
- Sanitation points will be made clear.
- All vehicles driving in campsite area will observe a strict speed limit of 5mph.
- The entrances will be clearly signed and lit during periods of darkness.
- Visitors may arrive at the campsite from 12 noon on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2020
- Visitors are asked to leave the campsite by 12 noon on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April 2020
- Strictly NO Generators

## ***Kelmarsh Country Show Campsite Rules 2020***

- All tents and caravans must be pitched as directed by the organisers.
- A minimum 6 meters firebreak must be maintained at all times between rows. Persons pitching / encroaching on the 6m fire gap will be asked to move immediately.
- The pitch must be kept tidy and clean, all refuse must be removed and disposed of correctly on vacating the site.
- Do not enter or cross any area marked out of bounds by fencing or hazard tape.
- No holes pits or drainage channels to be dug on the campsite.
- It is highly recommended that each outfit carries a fire extinguisher and ensure everyone knows how to operate such equipment.
- No fires' are allowed in any area what so ever.
- Barbeques must be purpose built and portable, standing clear of the Ground. There must be no possibility of damage to the ground. Only fuels for the specific use on Barbeques should be used.
- No cooking inside your tent.
- Should you discover a fire, sound the alarm and notify the campsite security team immediately.
- The contents of chemical toilets must only be emptied at the disposal point provided.
- A suitable receptacle, which must not be allowed to overflow should be used for collection of wastewater and emptied away clear of the campsite.
- Current driving license holder ONLY to drive on the campsite.
- Vehicle drivers, motorcyclists and cyclists are required to adhere to the sites 5mph speed limit at all times.
- Please show care and consideration for everyone on the site and those visiting the event.
- Music and other entertainment systems must not inconvenience other people on the site.
- It is the responsibility of parents and guardians to ensure children are supervised at all times, whilst on the campsite.
- No illegal substances to be brought on to the campsite.
- Passes must be carried with you at all times and will be subject to checks by security staff.
- Carry your valuables with you. Any valuables left in your accommodation or cars are left at your own risk.
- Litter must be placed in the bins provided.
- No quads, ATVs, motorbikes, mini-motorbikes or similar vehicles.
- No fireworks.
- Dogs must be kept under control and on a lead at all times. It is your duty to clean up after your dog.
- Ball games must not interfere with other site users.
- Access to the show site will only be available on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> and Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2020, from 9:00am to 17:00pm.
